Cook Stoves Save Lives and Trees

It's amazing what a simple cook stove can do. It can literally save lives—and trees.

A fuel-efficient cook stove saves up to 75% of the firewood needed for an open fire. Each stove can save one 20-year-old forest tree each year. With less need for fuel, women don't have to spend hours each day collecting scarce firewood and carrying the heavy loads home on their backs.

A stove also takes smoke out of the house through a pipe, saving women from inhaling smoke equivalent to 20 cigarettes a day. This protects the health of women who otherwise are prone to severe respiratory problems, and prolongs their lives.

A cook stove also helps prevent burns from open fires for both women and children.

A simple cook stove can dramatically improve the health and lives of women and children, making them better able to lift themselves out of poverty.
